

Tunkhannock SkillsUSA Students Compete at State Competition Autumn Henning earns trip to Nationals!!!

Five members of Tunkhannock's SkillsUSA Chapter participated in the State SkillsUSA Leadership/Technology Competitions held in Hershey April 1-3rd. The team is under the guidance of Mr. John Shaffer, TASD School-to-Career Coordinator.

SkillsUSA is an international youth organization that promotes career/ technology training on the secondary and post-secondary levels. Students competing earned that opportunity by placing first in the district competition held in December at the Susquehanna County Career and Technology Center and Tunkhannock Area High School.

Tunkhannock had two students medal and all five students place at state competition. Autumn Henning (Sr.) won the Gold in *Job Interview*, Tiffany Rule (Jr.) won the bronze in *Technical Computer Applications*, Courtney Mitchell (Jr.) 5th in *Graphic Communications*, Karl Carichner (Soph.) 7th in *Electronic Applications*, and Michael Forba (Jr.) 10th in *Electronics Technology*.

Autumn's first place finish in *Job Interview* is the first State Champion for TAHS in nearly 10 years. As a Gold medalist Ms. Henning is eligible to move on to the SkillsUSA National Leadership Conference in Kansas City, MO June 22-27th.
