

What is School-Wide Positive Behavior Support?

School Wide Positive Behavior Support is a collaborative, assessment based approach to developing effective interventions for problems school-wide. The emphasis is on pro-active, educative, and reinforcement based strategies to achieve meaningful and durable behavior and lifestyle outcomes.

- Proactive: Trying to prevent inappropriate behaviors by putting procedures in place and if needed changing the environment.
- Education: Teaching the students what we expect of them while at school. Teaching students the school rules.
- Reinforcement Based: Giving students rewards for when they follow the school's expectations (RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, CARING, TRUSTWORTHINESS, CITIZENSHIP). Students receive verbal praise, Tiger Paw stickers, Tiger Paws and other incentives.
