 - IEP
 - If close to cutoff → Remediate → Retest
 - If not → rewrite IEP to graduate to District credits requirements

- PBA Review
 - Move out of remediation class
 - Begin for English
 - Not getting feedback from the state
 - TA one of two districts in state doing PBA

- Data Review by Subject
 - Showing improvement!
 - Jan scores due February 29
 - When can we expect December scores?

- Recommendations
 - Students into Modern Algebra 1 only if proficient in BOTH modules
 - Adv/Pro or show growth for graduation
 - All subjects: Test → Remediate → Retest → PBA
