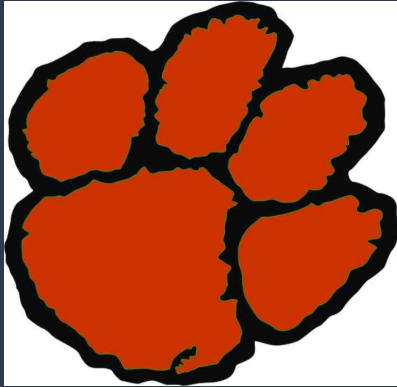

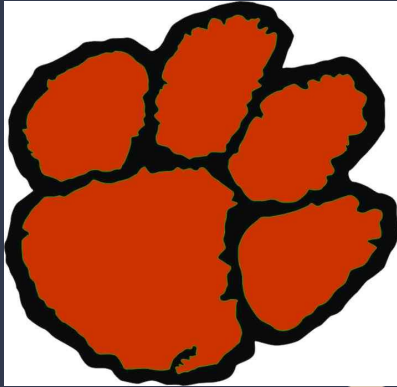
Completed Projects-

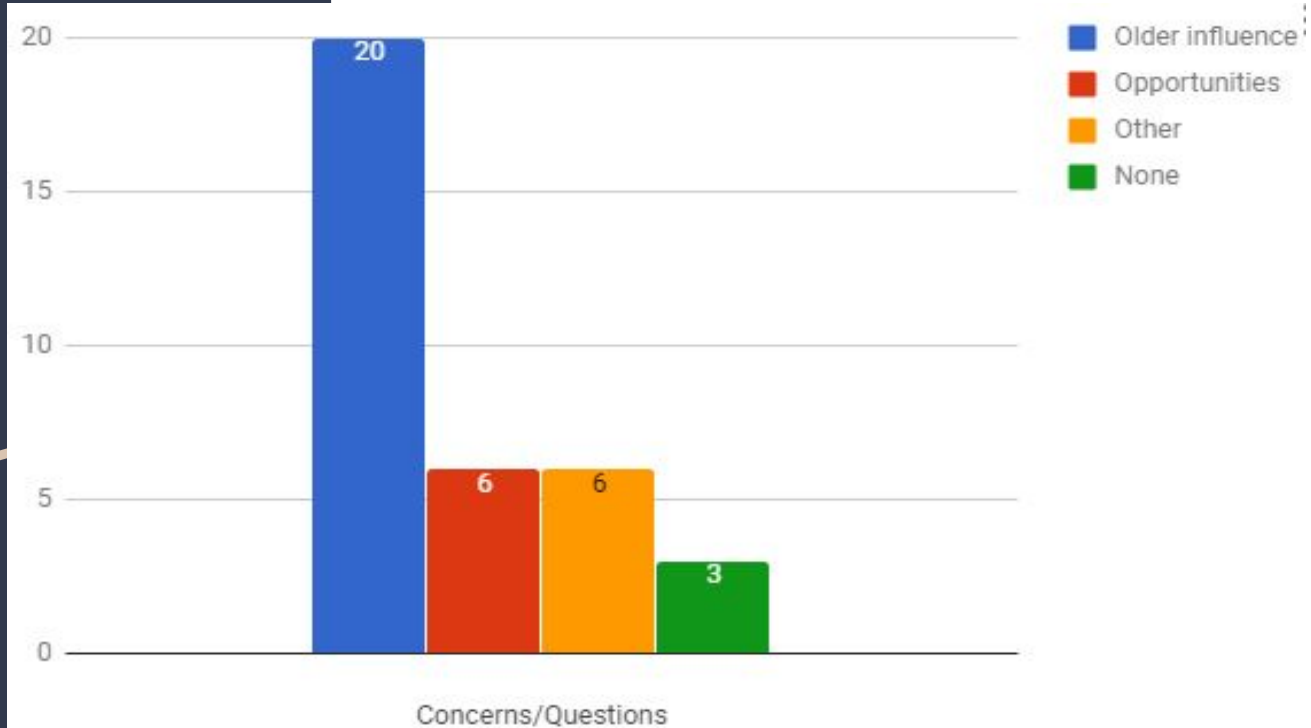

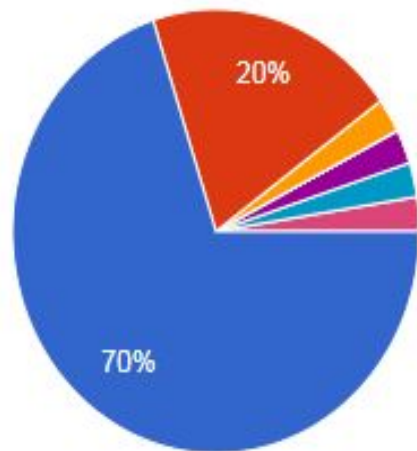

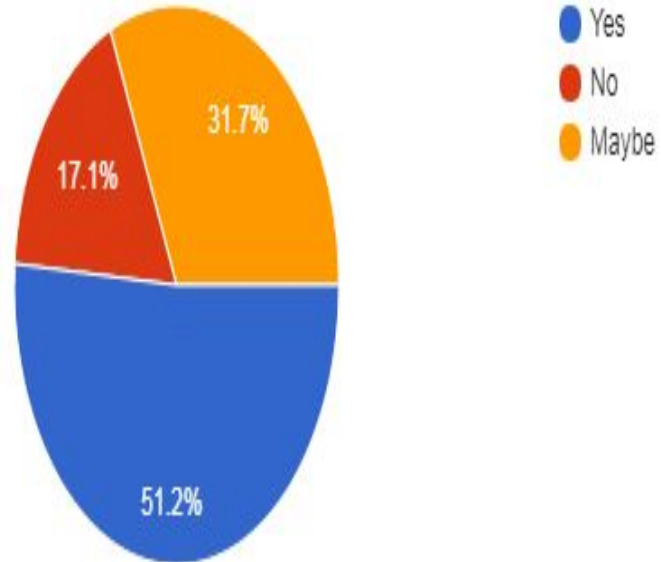

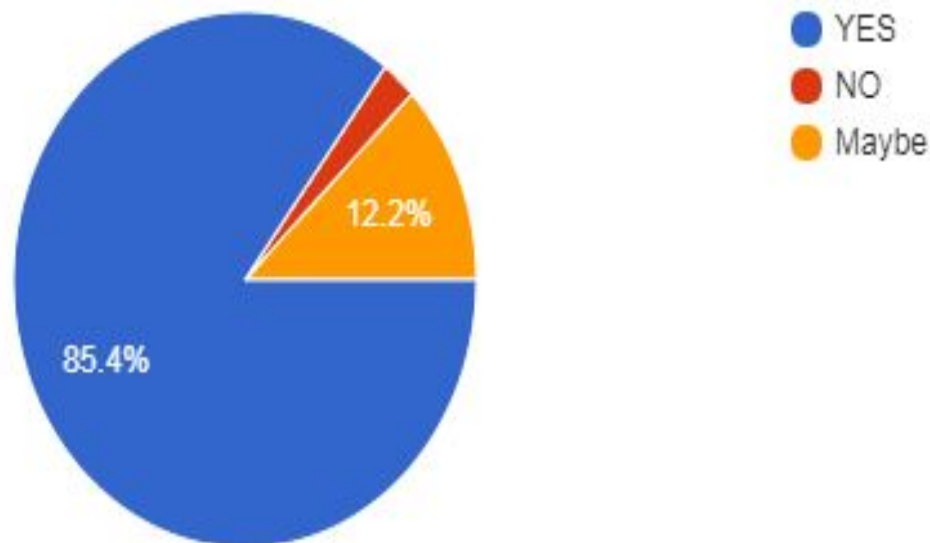
4. Are you hopeful of any school related opportunities that will be now ADDED due to your child transitioning to the high school for 8th grade?

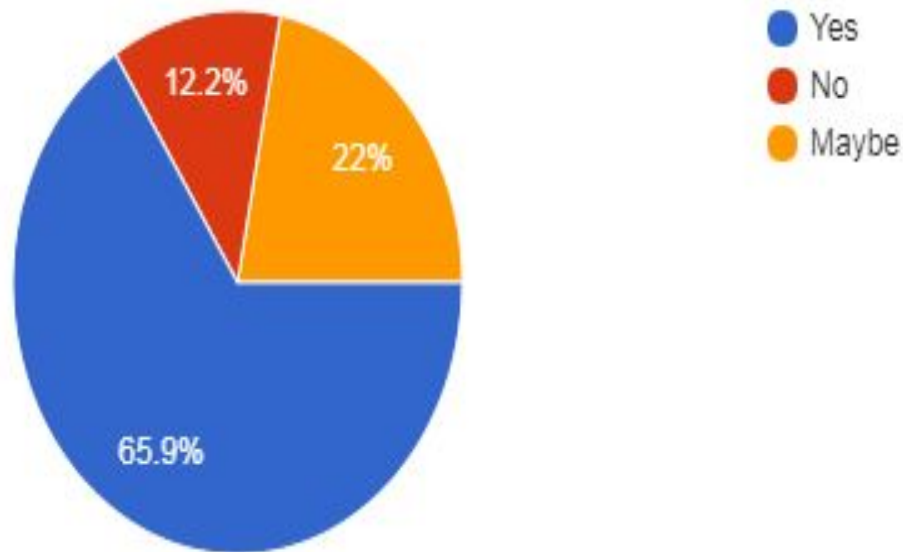
5. If provided a web link of information about clubs and activities available at the high school, would this be helpful...ngage your child in the school culture?

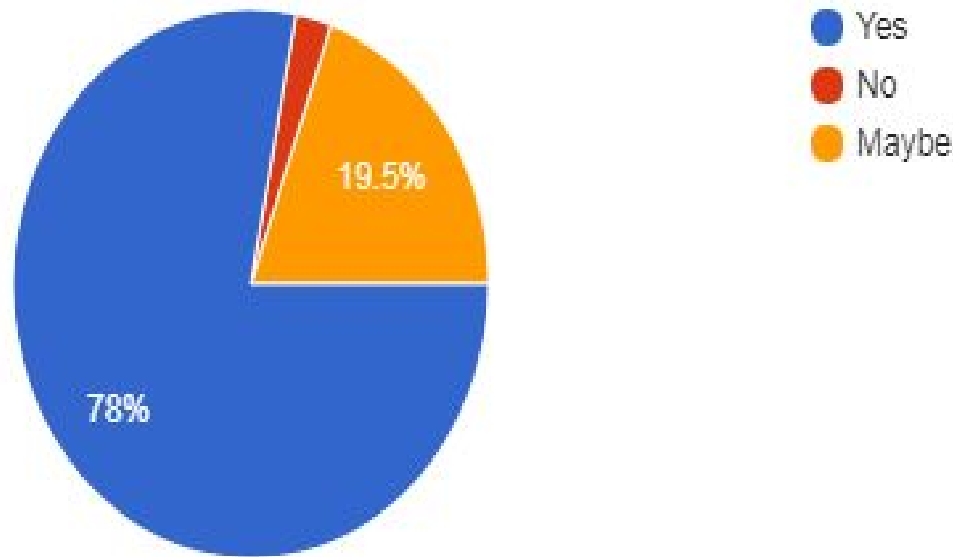
6. IF you had an opportunity to have your child take a class to explore the languages offered 9-12 would you be i...e Latin, Spanish and German classes?

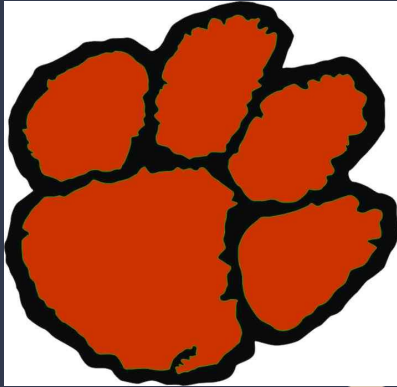


7. IF you had an opportunity to have your child take a class to explore the Career and Technical programs (CTC) ...metals, and wood technology classes?

3. Inventory/Plan for memorabilia/memorials-Evans Falls, Mehoopany, and Mill City

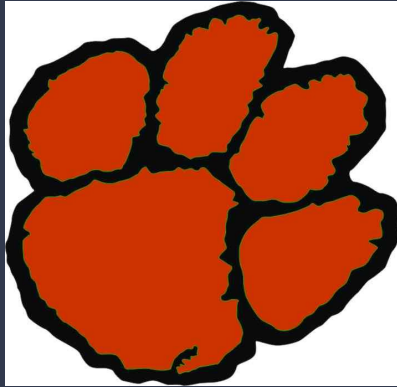

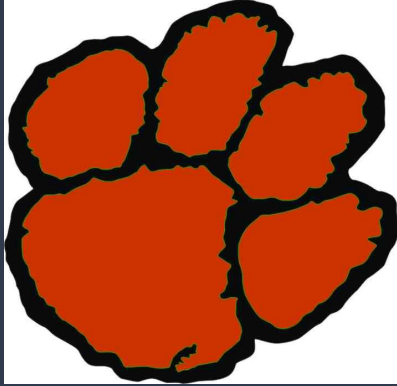
4. From the district wide supplies inventory, the TASD received a \$285 refund from a surplus of old toners

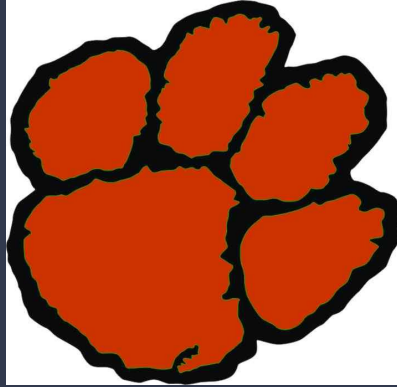

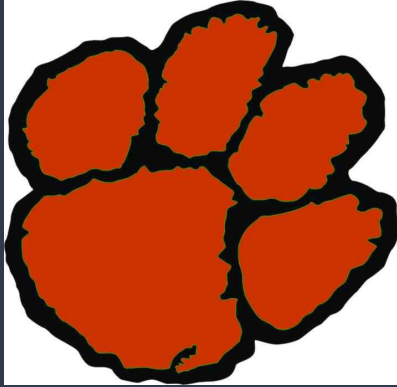

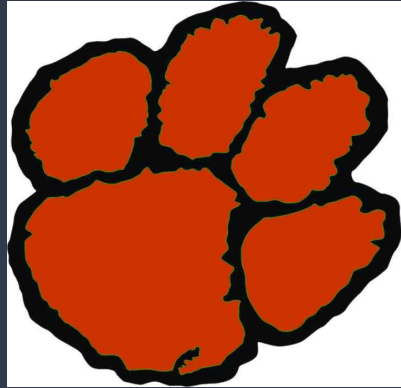
