TITLE I PROGRAM—PARENT INVOLVEMENT PLAN

The Tunkhannock Area School District strongly endorses the involvement of parents as our partners to ensure that they are included in the educational development and academic achievement of their children. It is our belief that all children can learn and that a child's education is a responsibility to be shared by the school, the family, and the community. The involvement of families is viewed as an ongoing process that encourages parent support and guidance. Through the many opportunities for involvement and communication, parents can participate in the design and implementation of our district's Title I program at the Roslund Elementary School. To this end, because the Tunkhannock Area School District supports parent involvement, the Title I program at the Roslund Elementary School and participating parents jointly developed and agreed upon the following policy:

The Roslund Elementary School will:

1. Convene an annual meeting for Title I parents, at a convenient time, which all participating parents shall be invited and encouraged to attend, to inform parents of Roslund Elementary School's participation under Title I and to explain the requirements of Title I and the right of the parent to be involved.
2. Offer a flexible number of meetings, such as morning or evening, and provide transportation, child care or home visits with Title I funds.
3. Involve Title I parents in an organized, ongoing and timely way, in the planning, review and improvement of Title I parent policies.
4. Involve Title I parents, in an organized, ongoing and timely way, in planning, review and improvement of school-wide programs, where applicable.
5. Provide Title I parents timely information about Title I.
6. Provide Title I parents with a description of the curriculum in use at the school, the forms of academic assessments used to measure student progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet.
7. Provide Title I parents (if requested by parents) opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate (as appropriate) in decisions relating to the education of their children, and respond to such suggestions as soon as practically possible.
8. Jointly develop a school-parent compact.
