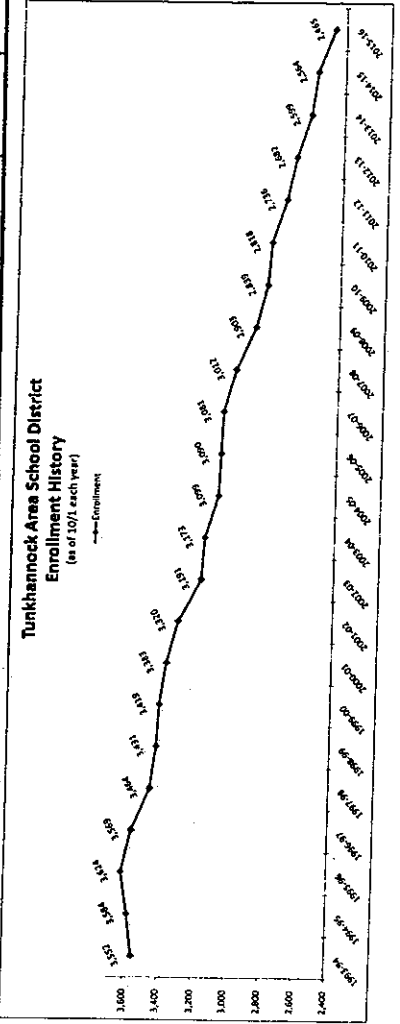

Dear Mr. Galicki and School Board Members,

I am writing to request the approval of an overnight field trip for the Tunkhannock Area High School Band and Select Chorus. This performing group has taken trips for the past twenty years to Williamsburg, VA; Atlanta, GA, Disney World; Cleveland, OH, and Boston, MA.

We would like to take the students to Orlando, Florida to perform at Magic Kingdom. The trip will be arranged for the proposed dates of May 11<sup>th</sup> – May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The students are in the process of raising all funds for the trip. The group will be responsible for all costs, including transportation, events, food, and teacher substitutes. There will be no cost to the district.

There are 77 students signed up to attend the trip. Four teachers (2 female and 2 male) and some parents will be chaperones for the trip. All parent chaperones will be required to have school clearances. One of the chaperones will be a registered nurse or doctor. The high school students will be divided into small groups and a chaperone will be assigned to each group.

We are scheduled for a public performance at Magic Kingdom in Disney World, for which the band has successfully auditioned. The parade we have been selected for will occur at 2:30pm on Thursday, May 12<sup>th</sup>. In addition to the performance, a trip to Disney World lends itself to multiple educational experiences including, but not limited to, historical tours, exhibits, workshops, and countless other avenues for a educationally meaningful experience.

We feel these trips give students a once in a lifetime opportunity as well as allowing them to demonstrate their talents. This performance will be viewed by thousands of people from around the world and will only stand to serve our school well. We hope to be allowed to continue with these ventures.
