

Governor Edward G. Rendell signed the new Right-to-Know Law on February 14, 2009 fundamentally changing the way people access public records of their government. Government agencies must presume that a record is a public record available for inspection or copying. The new law requires government agencies, including school districts, to comply with the new regulations as set forth by the Right-to-Law Act of 2008. This new law changes the way citizens have access to public records of their government agencies and the way these government agencies process these requests.
