## ASVAB TESTING

If you are in the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade and need some help making career decisions, then think about taking the ASVAB.

The ASVAB Career Exploration Program can help you take steps toward finding a career that is right for you. You can benefit from the program whether you plan to pursue further education after high school or enter the workforce right away.

The program is designed to help you:

- Learn more about yourself and the world of work
- Explore occupations in line with your interests and skills
- Develop an effective strategy to realize your career goals

The ASVAB will be given on **Wednesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>**. Sign up today in the School Counseling Office. There is no cost to take the ASVAB.

## SAT / ACT TESTING INFORMATION

The **LATE** registration deadline for the **October 5, 2019 SAT** is September 24, 2019. The test is given here at TAHS. Students must register online at [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com) through their College Board account. The cost of SAT is \$49.50 and SAT with Essay is \$64.50, PLUS \$30 for the late fee.

**TODAY** is the deadline to register for the **October 26, 2019 ACT**. Students can register online at [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org). ACTs are given on this date at, King's College, Scranton HS, Wyalusing HS, and Valley View HS. The cost for an ACT (no writing) is \$52, the cost for an ACT with Writing is \$68. Late registration extends until October 4th but an additional fee of \$30 applies if you choose this option.

**There is information in the School Counseling Office for two SAT Prep courses.** One is through Wilkes University and it is running on Saturdays & Sundays at the end of October. Students may pick up a registration form in the SC Office. The other is through PSU Wilkes-Barre. They offer online and in-person options. Students can pick up an information sheet regarding the courses in the SC Office as well.
